Opera Workshop For Advanced Singers: For over 22 years the Opera Workshop has gained a national reputation as *the* place for advanced singers to come for an intense, artistic growth experience. The workshop is process oriented and designed to bridge the gap between voice student and young professional as faculty work as a team to guide 18 students towards being more polished and free artists. **Vocal Techniques Workshop:** Designed to dovetail into the OW program, 10 University level vocal students improve and enhance their singing and performance techniques through individual lessons and master classes. **Professional Development Workshop:** 7 career level vocalists participate in an intensive 5 day workshop to fine tune specific needs.






WHALE OF A TALE THEATRE, Ron Kelly Spurles, Director






