The PAFI -Young Artist Program is for committed pianists of all ages who seek to perfect their skills, broaden their artistic vision and immerse themselves into an intensive learning environment.

The Young Artist Program is selective and open to conservatory-level pianists. A maximum of 20 pianists will be selected as participants based on their audition CD/DVD.

The curriculum consists of six piano lessons with renowned artist teachers, master classes, and special hands-on art workshops.

In addition to attending all guest artist and gala concerts, students are expected to perform in Young Artist recitals and are eligible for the PAFI Piano Competition.
